Dennis P. McHugh Piermont Public Library Director's Report July 9, 2025

General Library Updates

The RCLS Road Trip program has started at all RCLS libraries. Piermont has already given out several booklets and we have welcomed visitors from other library systems. Patrons receive raffle tickets for each library they visit. The program will run until the end of September.

The library will be closed on Saturday, July 12, during Piermont's annual Bastille Day celebration.

Programming

Adults

The library hosted the Piermont Film Festival on Sunday, June 8. The festival had a theme of environmental justice this year, with "Against the Current - Music and Activism on the Hudson River" and a short film titled "Windows of the Flyway" named the winners. One of the subjects of "Against the Current" held a short Q&A at the end of the program. We had 8 attendees.

The public was invited to meet with the library's new Director on June 11. We had 63 attendees.

Beginner Mah Jongg wrapped up mid-June and was popular among its attendees. Students requested more classes in the future. This July we are offering Beginner Canasta with the same instructor, also on Fridays.

The library is offering a summer reading program for adults, involving weekly raffle submissions for each book they read. This program will run until the end of August.

Rochelle Spooner returned to the library to offer Chair Yoga to 9 attendees.

"The Lion Women of Tehran" drew 10 attendees at June's Adult Book Club. The July selection is "A Kidnapping in New York."

In July, the library will be bringing back evening movie screenings for adults, as well as introducing a Jeopardy-style trivia game.

Young Adults

The library is offering a summer reading program for teens, involving weekly raffle submissions for each book they read. This program will run until the end of August.

Children

Children's summer reading will run throughout July, with weekly crafts, activities, and takehome prizes for all attendees. As of this report, we have 31 children signed up.

Healthy Eating with dietician Caitlin Rulli drew 12 healthy eaters!

This month's art exhibit featured the final projects from Alexis Starke's Spring art class sessions. Visitors were wowed by the incredible talent from our young artists! The reception for this exhibit drew around 145 attendees.

Attendance for our storytime sessions has also been increasing, with our children's room filled to capacity in recent sessions.

Technology

Frontline has ordered the new computer equipment for our technology upgrade that the Board approved last month and the machines have arrived at their facility. Four outdated staff and four outdated patron computers will be replaced in July. An additional four patron computers will not be replaced- the library will determine a public use for the space currently occupied by those computers.

Staffing

The Library Director has passed the required Civil Service exam requirement to be reclassified as a Permanent Full-Time Employee from Provisional Full Time Employee.

Collections

We have shifted a large number of our "new" books to our regular collection to accommodate new orders that are arriving.


Building






