# Dennis P. McHugh Piermont Public Library Director's Report October 15, 2025

#### **General Library Updates**

The RCLS Road Trip program wrapped up at the end of September. We had visitors all the way up to the very last day. Two visitors completed their *entire* road trips at our library. During September, we had 59 road trip participants come into the library for stamps and raffle tickets.

We have scheduled a Book Sale, starting November 9 to November 15. Patrons can drop of donations during regular open hours from October 20 to November 5. We are accepting hardcover, softcover, and children's books that are in decent condition, as well as DVDs and music CDs. We are discouraging donations of textbooks, workbooks, tapes, VHS, and vinyl, as well as any books in poor condition.

We received a check from the Spitzer Charitable Trust for the grant for general operating support. A letter of appreciation has been mailed and funds have been deposited.

#### **Programming**

#### Adults

Friday afternoon movies at 2pm continued throughout September with small attendance but a growing group of regular attendees nonetheless. We have heard positive comments regarding the selection of new, under-the-radar films with critical acclaim, so we will continue to offer these types of films as often as possible.

Our art gallery this month featured work by Eileen Brady Nelson, "Cyanotype," and 76 people attended the opening reception.

We screened the annual reading of the names in honor of those who were lost on 9/11.

This month's book club selection was *The Borrowed Life of Frederick Fife* and had 15 attendees.

#### Children

Patrons are steadily adjusting to our new Storytime schedules on Wednesday mornings. Ms. Nancy also offered two new programs this month: Fun with Legos, and a Book Adventures Book Club.

Our always popular art classes for children and teens resumed at the end of the September and will continue on through the Fall season. Classes are currently full and on a waitlist basis.

#### **Technology**

We purchased an Apple HDMI converter for our A/V equipment to better accommodate visiting presenters who need to present on MacBook.

#### **Staffing**

Staff have done a commendable job of filling vacant hours during a period of temporary staffing shortage, ensuring uninterrupted service for our patrons.

The Library Director attended a Demco Book Care Workshop, through our LARC membership, at Nyack Library this month and will be including book care best practices in a future staff training.

#### **Collections**

We learned this week that one of our book vendors, Baker & Taylor, will be shuttering its doors. Many libraries utilize B&T for their book leasing- thankfully, we utilize McNaughton subscription services already, so our leasing process for adult books will not be interrupted. I will be working with Ms. Nancy, who uses B&T for children's purchasing, to determine a new vendor for our new children's books purchasing.

#### **Building**


The library's gutters were cleaned this month.

The Library was invited to table at the Piermont Community Center's Open House on September 28, where we answered questions from the community, promoted our upcoming events, and debuted our new library bookmark!






